## DESCRIPTION OF BENEVOLENT GIVING COMMITTEE AWARDS

### ROTARY CLUB OF ABBEVILLE LA.

Our funds went to purchase cattle feed (\$5000) and the rebuilding of two fire stations

### MY SISTERS HOUSE

Funds paid for day care in conjunction with the Women to Work program

### SCHOOL ACTIVITIES FOR EVERYONE (S.A.F.E.)

Funds used to pay for out of pocket expenses for low income high school students wishing to participate in school activities but cannot afford to do so.

### FIRST TEE OF SACRAMENTO

Award provides for 10 “golferships” for low income students wishing to participate in the First Tee program

### BUDGETEX - Jonas Salk

Award used to purchase books for books used in the school wide reading program at Jonas Salk

### ENCINA HIGH SCHOOL

Grant used to pay for supplies and incentive awards for the Superstars program designed to improve student performance through positive intervention

### PROJECT R.I.D.E. (Riding Instruction Designed for Education)

Provided farrier services for four horses during a one year period

### HEADLANDS INSTITUTE

Grant enables low income and underserved Sacramento area youth to attend field science programs at the Marin Headlands campus

### COTTAGE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

To provide the opportunity for 5 sixth grade students to attend natural science camp at Westminster Woods

### UC DAVIS HEARING CENTER

Our funds will subsidize the cost of a hearing aid for a child ineligible for California Childrens Services money.
